

**GLOBAL ADVOCATES**  
**GENERAL COUNSEL COMMITMENT**

As a Global Advocates General Counsel volunteering with ANM, I hereby make the following commitments:

1. I will strive to maintain my walk with and witness for the Lord. This includes, but is not limited to, prayer, studying His Word, making healthy family and personal relationships a priority, keeping my own house in order, and maintaining a relationship with a local church and accountability to a local pastor or other church leader--all as commanded by His Word.
2. I will pray for indigenous missions and missionaries regularly. In particular, I will regularly and specifically pray for the native missionary group I am serving as General Counsel (the "Group").
3. I will give financially to the Group and/or to specific missionaries or projects associated with the Group, as the Lord leads.
4. I will "go" and/or serve at home as the Lord leads. At the present time, I commit to serving as a Global Advocates General Counsel as described in the Global Advocates brochure and in this Commitment. At this time, I am making a six-month commitment to this work, with the understanding that I may withdraw at any time the Lord leads or as may be necessary because of circumstances unforeseen at this time.
5. As a Global Advocates General Counsel, I will work with the Global Advocates Coordinator to designate the Group that I will serve as "General Counsel." I understand that ANM will make every effort to designate a group in a country and people group of my preference. It is understood that the term "General Counsel" does not imply that I will, or obligate me to, provide legal or other services for the Group. Rather, "General Counsel," as used in the Global Advocates Ministry, means that I will advocate for the needs of the Group use my best efforts to locate resources to meet such needs.
6. As a Global Advocates General Counsel, I will establish a relationship with the Group leader through emails, faxes, letters or even a personal visit to learn first-hand about the legal, financial, spiritual and other needs of the group. These needs may include such things as prayer support, a wheelchair, referral to a local legal advisor, common sense counsel, bail money, funds for equipment or buildings, rights training and materials, itineration and/or hosting for a missionary's U.S. trip, and/or simple encouragement.
7. I will use my best efforts to locate resources to meet the needs of the group I serve—whether by providing for those needs myself or networking with other

individuals, foundations, bar associations, or others. If such needs include legal services, I will use my best efforts to obtain indigenous legal help as appropriate and to assist the attorneys providing such legal help as I am able and as the Lord may lead. I will use creative methods to advocate for the group I serve with a goal of maximizing spiritual and material blessings to it. This may include, but is neither limited to or required, leading or participating in short-term trips to serve and encourage the Group, and to cast the vision of indigenous missions and the Group to trip participants.

8. I understand that I have the freedom to serve as a Global Advocates General Counsel as the Holy Spirit may lead. I will also be accountable to ANM for my conformity to ANM's ethical standards, organizational culture, and the broad outlines of the Global Advocates General Counsel ministry as described in its brochure. I will communicate regularly with my ANM Global Advocates Coordinator.
9. I have read ANM's Statement of Faith and agree with it.
